Chief Bantes explained that a Community Paramedic/EMT program will start this fall at Ridgeview Highlands. The fire department will be meeting with the residents and addressing various needs and answering their questions and concerns, the object of this program is to reduce call volume to certain facilities.

The Chief said they are working on an alternate response vehicle (ARV) for EMS calls between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
