The Grand Chute Police Department is currently accepting applications for the position of Community Service Officer. The position of Community Service Officer is a non-sworn part-time (LTE) position with the Town of Grand Chute. A Community Service Officer allows individuals to participate in some of the daily activities that police officers are involved in. The Grand Chute Police Department is committed to educating and developing Community Service Officers to grow into a Law Enforcement position. Ideal Candidates will be in their 1st or 2nd Semester of Technical College or 1st year of a 4-year program.

Community Service Officers are involved in:

- Investigation of Animal Calls
- Traffic Direction
- Investigation of Traffic Accidents
- Investigation of Theft Complaints
- Disabled Vehicles
- Variety of tasks assigned by the Shift Supervisor

Community Service Officers with the Grand Chute Police Department work approximately 16 to 24 hours per week. Community Service Officers are paid \$12.52 per hour.

The Hiring Process for Community Service Officer may include, but are not limited to:

Written Test
Panel Interview
Background Investigation
Supervisory Interview
Drug Test
