



## PARK RULES & ORDINANCES

Thank you for selecting a Town of Grand Chute Park for your picnic.  
Please be aware of the following park rules and ordinances:

- No tents allowed.
- All decorations or attachments must be removed from pavilion.
- No dunk tanks, amusement devices, large inflatables or rides without prior approval of the Town Board. Proof of certificate of insurance required.
- No domestic animals allowed.
- No fires except in designated receptacles. Leave hot ashes in grills.
- No Littering. Dispose of refuse in appropriately marked containers.
- Park Hours: Sunrise until 11:00 P.M.
- No vehicles may be driven or parked on grass areas.
- No stakes driven for horseshoe playing.
- Loudspeakers and amplified music must be on LOW!
- No fireworks allowed.
- **Fermented malt beverages (beer and wine coolers) require a permit from the Town Clerk. This may be obtained on the day the pavilion key is picked up. Hard liquor is prohibited.**
- Park fees will not be refunded if cancelled less than 14 days prior to the rental date.
- No refunds due to inclement weather.
- Any damage to the park resulting from the use of these facilities or any park property shall be the responsibility of the person named on the reservation form.
- Return keys to the Town Hall between 10 am and 4 pm the first business day after your reservation to ensure the return of the security deposit.

Any person designated by the Grand Chute Park Commission shall have the right to terminate the use of this permit and shall further have jurisdiction to close the use of said park at any time it is necessary for protection of park property or due to disturbance of residents adjacent to the park.
