The Grand Chute Police Department is accepting applications from responsible and qualified individuals for the position of Police Lieutenant.

The position of lieutenant is a senior management/command level law enforcement position with oversight responsibility for a division within the police department. Work involves monitoring, supervising, and evaluating activities of subordinates to ensure the delivery of high quality police services; budgeting and fiscal control; policy development and implementation; enhancing organizational effectiveness by researching and implementing best practices; completing special reports and assignments; assisting with development of department goals and objectives; ensuring organizational readiness through training and personnel development; commanding critical incidents; and other duties as assigned.

Applicants must:

- be a State of Wisconsin Certified Police Officer;
- possess a Bachelor's degree; and
- have 5 years full time law enforcement experience with a minimum of 2 years of police supervisory experience.
