RESOLUTION, SERIES OF TBR-02-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GRAND CHUTE, OUTAGAMIE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, SUPPORTING WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WISDOT) TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) AWARD CYCLE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Grand Chute, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, supports a TAP application submitted to WisDOT for the 2018-2022 award cycle, said application for a project to construct an off-road, bicycle and pedestrian trail along the west side of N. Lynndale Drive/CTH A from W. Grand Chute Boulevard to the Bubolz Nature Preserve; and,

WHEREAS, the Grand Chute Park Commission voted unanimously in support of the project at its meeting on Monday, November 13, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the Town recognizes that WisDOT reimburses project sponsors for the federal share of eighty percent (80%) of the approved TAP project costs, up to the limit of the federal award amount; and,

WHEREAS, in light of the minimum twenty percent (20%) match requirement, the Town commits to securing the matching funds if it accepts the grant funding and commits to securing funds for the design and WisDOT design review for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of Supervisors for the Town of Grand Chute, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, if the Town is awarded funding by WisDOT for the 2018-2022 TAP award cycle the Town is authorized and agrees to accept the award and enter into all necessary agreements with WisDOT for the above-referenced project, and agrees to comply with all applicable laws, requirements, and regulations as outlined in the WisDOT 2018-2022 TAP application materials, the state-municipal agreement between WisDOT and the Town of Grand Chute, and any other program and/or project documentation.
