A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, TOWN OF GRAND CHUTE, OUTAGAMIE COUNTY, STATE OF WISCONSIN, MOVING WARDS 15-18 VOTING AT TOWN CENTER PARK TO INSTEAD VOTE AT TOWN HALL FOR THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION,

WHEREAS, the Town of Grand Chute did by resolution establish where polling locations would be for each ward, and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes 5.25(2) provides cities, villages, and towns with populations under 500,000 to establish polling places by the governing body, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Grand Chute does not have enough poll workers to operate three polling locations for the November 3, 2020 Presidential Election due to cancellations due to the COVID-19 outbreak,

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Elections Commission will be promoting absentee voting across the State by sending absentee applications to all registered voters who do not have an absentee request on file,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Grand Chute, Board of Supervisors, that the Board approves moving Wards 15-18 from voting at Town Center Park to instead vote at Town Hall for the November 3, 2020 Presidential Election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Clerk be directed to send a copy of this resolution to the Outagamie County Clerk.
