RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT SUBMITTAL OF WISDOT SURFACE
TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM- URBAN (STP- U) GRANT APPLICATIONS

WHEREAS, the Town of Grand Chute, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, supports the application submittal to the WisDOT Surface Transportation Program - Urban grant program for the following project:

1. N. McCarthy Road reconstruction from Michaels Drive to W. Brookview Drive
- the proposed reconstructed urban typical section optimizes existing lanes with planned improvements for turn lanes with sidewalk on both sides.

WHEREAS, WisDOT has begun soliciting projects for the FFY 2023-2026 program cycle, which includes the Surface Transportation Program - Urban (STP - U). Construction of newly selected projects will take place in 2026 or 2027.

WHEREAS, the objective of the WisDOT Surface Transportation Program - Urban is to improve transportation on Wisconsin's federal-aid-eligible roads and streets in urban areas.

WHEREAS, project eligibility requires the designated roadway to be functionally classified as a Collector or higher and it must be located within the urban area boundary.

WHEREAS, STP - U projects within urbanized areas are selected by each Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) based on its own selection criteria. Applications are due to the MPO and WisDOT NE Region by June 3, 2022. The Appleton MPO Committee will then meet to select the most qualified projects in the area.

WHEREAS, the MPO promotes the Complete Streets concept and requires that any project receiving federal funding will adhere to this policy. The following criteria are used to evaluate and prioritize candidate projects:

- Plan Consistency
- Preservation of the Existing System
- Capacity Needs
- Safety
- Multimodality
- Capital Programming
- Funding Availability


WHEREAS, project sponsors must fund a portion of the total project costs. WisDOT recommends federal funding be approved at the 80% maximum, but allows TIP Committees to provide as low as 50% federal funding at approval. All urbanized areas (population greater than 50,000) receive a fixed allocation each program cycle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town hereby supports submittal of the WisDOT Surface Transportation Program - Urban (STP - U) grant application for the N. McCarthy Road reconstruction project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town hereby authorizes and empowers the Director of Public Works, its official or employee, to act on its behalf to sign and submit the grant application.
