The Grand Chute Police Department is accepting applications from professional, responsible, qualified, and motivated leaders for the position of Police Lieutenant.

The position of Police Lieutenant is a first-level leadership position with oversight responsibility for members of the Patrol Division. Police Lieutenants are also empowered to develop, implement, and administer department programs and special projects.

Responsibilities include: monitor, supervise, and evaluate activities of sworn and civilian employees to ensure the delivery of high quality police services; administer the assignment of personnel and work duties in patrol operations; enhance organizational effectiveness by empowering and leading personnel and encouraging career advancement; assist with development of department goals and objectives; command critical incidents; and other duties as assigned. Work is performed under general supervision of the Field Operations Division Commander.

Applicants must:

- be a State of Wisconsin Certified Police Officer;
- possess an Associate's degree; and
- have at least three years of full-time law enforcement experience.

Compensation: Wage range for the position as of January 01, 2023, is \$80,870 to \$103,958 annually (\$38.88 to \$49.98 per hour). Starting wages will be dependent upon qualifications. Police Lieutenants receive overtime compensation and time and a half. The Town of Grand Chute also offers an excellent fringe benefits package.
