



## Part-time Firefighter Hiring Announcement

The Grand Chute Fire Department welcomes the applications of those interested in serving the community as a part-time firefighter with our organization. As a part-time firefighter with Grand Chute, you will gain first-hand experience serving as an emergency responder in a fast-paced, progressive, and well-equipped fire service organization. While on shift in one of our two recently constructed fire stations, you will work alongside both career and part-time firefighters eager to share their wealth of knowledge accumulated through years of service to our community. Training will be provided using the most advanced fire, rescue, and EMS equipment available, enabling you to put those very tools and skills to work as you respond to virtually every type of incident the fire service has to offer.



To be eligible to serve as a part-time firefighter you must be at least 18 years of age and possess a valid Wisconsin Driver's License. While previous training and experience is not required, certification as a State of Wisconsin Firefighter I and EMT is preferred (will need to obtain).

Monthly requirements of a part-time firefighter:

- Shall work shifts in 12-hour increments for a minimum of 48 hours per month with 12 of those hours working from 0700 to 1900 hours Monday –Saturday
- Shall attend a minimum of six hours per month of scheduled training
- Requirements can be met on a quarterly basis
